Accounts - Accommodation fees are payable in advance for the full time booked. There are no refunds for early departures.

Vehicles - All guest vehicles must be registered at reception before entering the park.

Children - Must be actively supervised by adult at all times. Parents / guardians are responsible for the actions of their children.

Laundry - Located at the far end of the main communal bathroom block.
Wash \$4:00 with 2 x \$2 coins.
Dryer \$4:00 with 2 x \$2 coins.
Washing powder can be purchased from reception during opening hours.

Barbecues - There is no charge for using the BBQs. Please be considerate for other guests by leaving them clean for their use.

Pets - We are a pet friendly Park by prior arrangement with management on authorised powered sites and unpowered sites only.

- No pets are allowed in cabin units.
- Any guests in violation of this policy will be required to vacate the premises immediately.
- No refunds will be given.

Rubbish & Recycling - Stations are located in front of the kitchen, opposite powered sites and beside lower communal facilities. Please take time to recycle.

Speed limit within Park - The speed limit for all vehicles is 15km/ph (walking pace only). Children have the right of way.

Fire Evacuation - Please familiarise yourself with the procedure on signage located in cabins and communal areas.

Rules of Entry / Stay - By entering the Park you have acknowledged your acceptance of all Park rules. We ask all guests to behave in a considerate and kind manner at all times.

We reserve the right to cancel the tenancy at any time of any person or group who behaves in an objectionable manner or who breaches Our Conditions of Stay or Health and safety and Fire Regulations.

Behaviour & Noise

- A good standard of behaviour is expected at all times.
- No excessive drinking, parties or loud music is permitted.
- Absolute quiet is strictly observed between **9PM - 7AM**

If you are experiencing problems with excessive noise or unreasonable behaviour, please inform reception or call 06 378 6454. We can only deal with a problem if you let us know about it.

Alcohol - May only be consumed on your own site or dining room and BBQ area.

Cabins/Units - Please do your dishes - dish washing by our staff is not included in your room rate. A minimum \$250 charge will apply to remove smoke odours or clean excessively dirty units.

NO REFUNDS FOR EARLY DEPARTURES

Damages - The cost of any damages to property will be recovered from the person whose name the unit is registered to.

Power - Camper-vans and caravans must have current electrical WOF to connect to power. Tents must only be connected through an approved isolation transformer or RCD safety switch.

Smoking - No smoking or vaping in cabins, surrounding areas or communal areas. Please dispose of cigarette butts sensibly and NOT on the ground or in our gardens.

VISITORS

- All visitors must register at reception on arrival.
- Visitor parking is not provided inside the park.
- Visitors must depart by **9PM**.
- A maximum of four visitors per site is permitted.
- We reserve the right to refuse visitors at busy times.

Fun activities

Trust House Recreation Centre

Situated only 5 minutes walk from Mawley Holiday Park where you'll find state-of-the-art gymnasium, four heated indoor pools incorporating a leisure pool with lazy river, a 7 lane lap pool, spa and sauna. Outdoor pools include a dive pool, toddlers pool and a 25m lido pool with 7 slide entry for summer fun.

ROAD SAFETY

Helmets must be worn when riding bikes and scooters in the park. Remain aware of traffic both on and off the roads. Please drive responsibly and look out for pedestrians. Always check around your car for children before reversing or driving.

BARBECUES

There is no charge for using a BBQ please clean after use & be considerate of other guests.

BE PREPARED FOR ALL WEATHER

Weather can change unexpectedly when camping. Make sure your camp sire is appropriately tied down. Be prepared and identify where you can take shelter if required.

WATCH YOUR STEP

Rocks, mud and other slip and trip hazards may be present in campgrounds. Please be mindful of where you are walking and use a torch at night.

QUIET TIME

Quiet time here at the park is from 6pm onwards, please be considerate of other guests.

DRINK RESPONSIBLY

Legal alcohol limits apply.

WASHER / DRYER

Both our washers and dryers are \$4.00 a load, \$2.00 Coins, see reception for change.

SUPERVISE CHILDREN

Children must be supervised at all times. Be aware of hazards, moving vehicles and the wild life of the park.

KEEP AREAS TIDY

Clean dishes after use and keep cooking areas tidy and wash dishes.
